Lunations and Long-term Aspects

This month the Full Moon occurs on December 6 in fellow Air Sign, Gemini, your 5th house of creativity, ego expression, romance, children, entertainment and speculation suggesting an ending, culmination or shift to a new phase of something in this part of your life. If your birthday is right around February 3 your natal Sun forms an aspect pattern known as a "Triangle of Potential" with the lunation which puts you in the proverbial driver's seat to guide and direct this energy in a satisfying way. One possibility is that a friend, associate through networking or organizational connections will help point you in the right direction to go after something you've been wanting for a while. Mars has just entered you sign which will give you an extra boost of energy toward pursuing one of your goals. December 21 is a busy day on the cosmic scene besides it being the Capricorn Ingress a.k.a. solstice, Winter Solstice in the Northern Hemisphere and Summer Solstice in the Southern Hemisphere. This is also the 2nd anniversary of the supposed end of the Mayan calendar, which gives it an interesting spin. Uranus stations direct on this date 18 minutes and 22 second before the Ingress. When the Sun goes into one of the Cardinal Signs it also marks the beginning of a new season. Cardinal Signs have forward-thrusting energy which implies change with the Ingress Chart used for several things including weather prediction and various fields with mundane and geopolitical astrology. Thus, it represents an energy boost and a planet stationing likewise throws a blast of energy out there. Mars is really settled into your sign by now and pushing you to

Two hours, thirty-two minutes and fifty seconds after the Ingress the New Moon occurs as the Moon slips into that side and conjoins the Sun. While the Moon was in Sagittarius for the Ingress and Jupiter station the influence was more on your opinion and attitude but now it's on planning and action, at least at the subconscious level.
